BACKGROUND

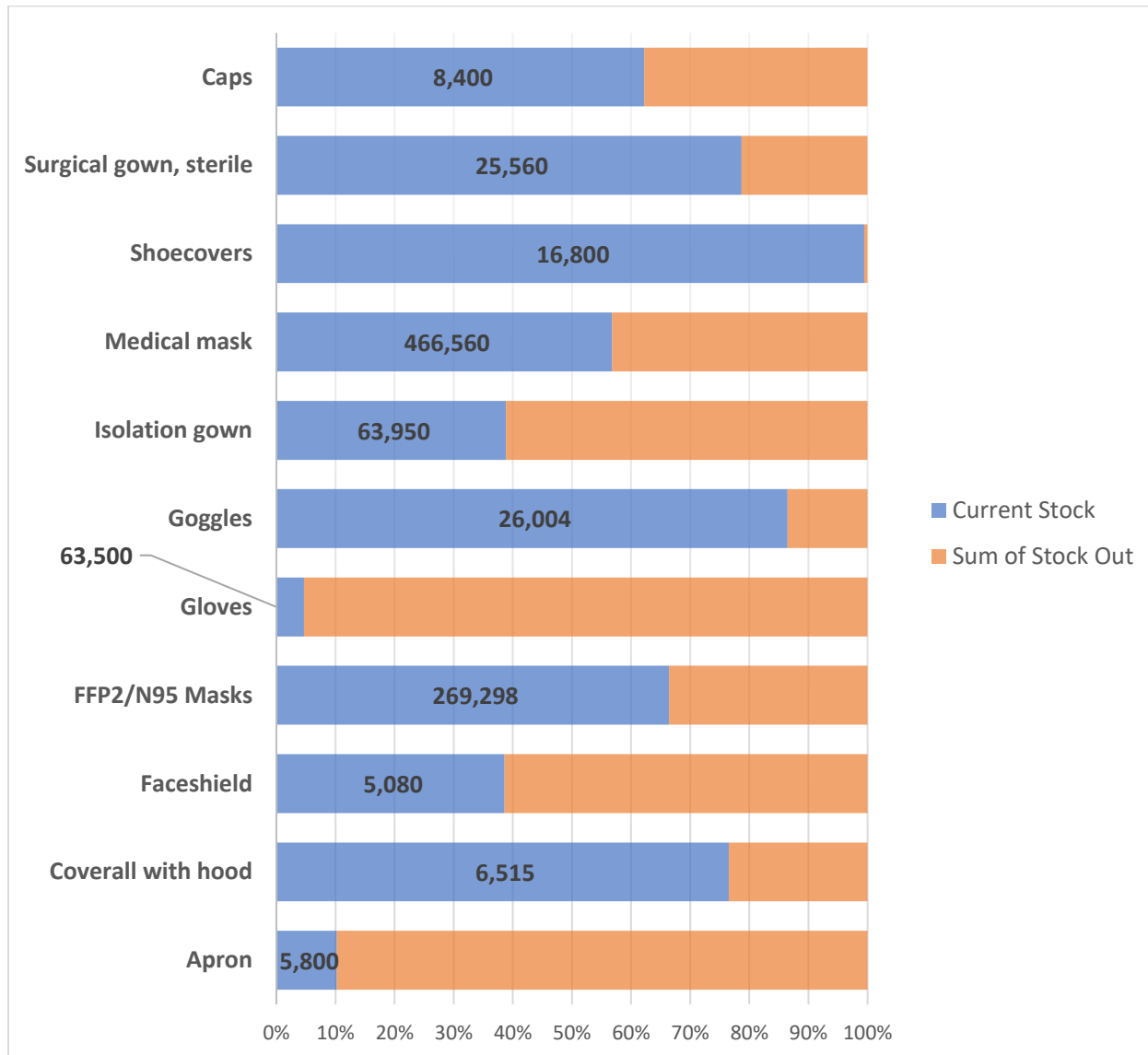

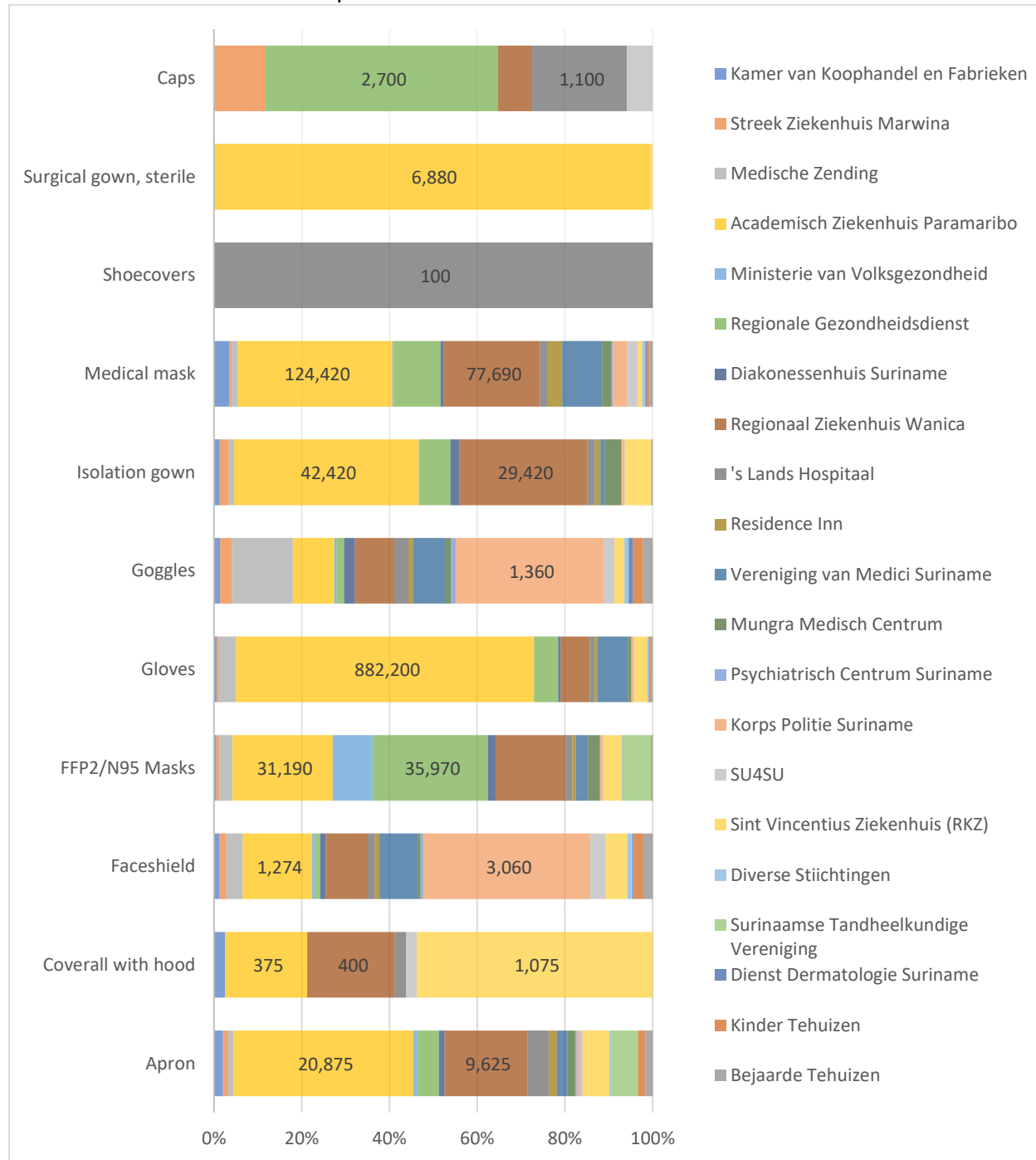
TABLE 1: CURRENT INVENTORY AND DISTRIBUTED JUNE 25TH – NOV 26TH

APPENDIX A. DESCRIPTION OF PRODUCT CATEGORIES

Item	Description	Picture
N95 masks	N95 or FFP2 respirator, or higher. Good breathability with design that does not collapse against the mouth (e.g. duckbill, cup shaped).	
Medical masks	Medical mask, good breathability, internal and external faces should be clearly identified	
Face shields	Face shield: Made of clear plastic and provides good visibility to both the wearer and the patient.	
Nitrile & Surgical gloves	Gloves, examination, nitrile, powder-free, non-sterile.	
Coveralls	Protective clothing that shields like armor but moves comfortably. all while staying guarded against hazardous materials associated with on-the-job duties. keeps small-sized particles, liquids and aerosols away	
Isolation Gowns	Single use, disposable, length mid-calf	
Eye goggles	Good seal with the skin of the face, flexible PVC frame to easily fit with all face contours with even pressure, enclose eyes and the surrounding areas, clear plastic lens with fog and scratch resistant treatments, adjustable band to secure firmly.
